School Policies:

- 1. No gum or candy

- 7. Conduct:
 - **♡** When a *Lab Situation has been started*, if you interrupt or act inappropriately, points will be deducted from your grade for that lab.
 - □ If a Focus Time has been started, everyone is to stop whatever he or she is doing and immediately listen to important directions. Points will be deducted from your grade for any distractions during this time! Inappropriate behaviors at any other times will be asked to sign the "Nudge List" at the front of the room. Students with their names appearing a couple of times will have their parents called to remind them of appropriate behavior.
- 8. If you copy from a book, a computer, or another student, you will receive NO POINTS for your grade. Parents will be notified.
